They decided to continue the practice of selecting someone to chair the meeting just before we meet each Thursday at 6:00 PM in the library at Lowell Correctional Institution, 11120 NW Gainesville Rd., Ocala Fl. 34482.this is due to the fact they cannot always attend. They group will be voting on a GSR at the next business meeting. While it is a Behind the Walls meeting, the warden will not allow the meeting to take place unless a woman or women from Na from outside the facility attend. And we need more women. Currently, I go along most weeks. We have 5 women in the Uncoast Area who have PIN numbers. In the Business meeting, the group conscious was to THANK THE FOREST AREA for the offer of \$20.00 a month for literature. The group decided to ask for Soft-covered Basic Texts at this time. Last month, Uncoast Area and two Home Groups in that Area donated 14 Basic Texts to that group. The group still needs 9 more BT's. As soon as the group receives enough BT's so that every woman has a book, , they stated will vote and decide what other literature would be beneficial.
