Forest Area Guidelines for Unity Banners

- Home groups must make a Narcotics Anonymous recovery related banner to participate.
- ➤ Three (3) or more home group members, whose group has made a banner, can go to another home group's meeting to seize their banner.
- A home group who has had their banner seized, can get their banner back by sending at least three (3) of their members to the captures meeting to get their banner back.
- ➤ A home group cannot get their banner back and seize a banner at the same meeting. A home group must attend one meeting to get their banner back and another meeting to seize the host home group's banner.
- > Home groups should bring their banner to each of their meetings.
- > Home groups should take great care of banners they have seized.
- ➤ If a home group does not have their banner at a meeting that another home group attends, to seize their banner, the target home group must surrender their banner as soon as possible to the captures home group, unless the banner was not at the meeting because it was already seized.
- ➤ If a home group owes their banner to another home group because they did not have it at the meeting, it cannot be seized by another group.
- When a home group has seized a banner, they must take it to each of their meetings in anticipation of its owner's home group coming to capture it back.
- ➤ Each month a report of which home groups have made a banner, and the status of that banner, will be compiled at the FASC and included in the FASC meeting minutes.
- ➤ If a group has had their banner captured, but has other group's banner(s), a visiting home group may capture the other group's banner.
