Dear Forest Area of Narcotics Anonymous,

I am an addict my name is Maggi C. There are currently 3 Behind The Walls meetings that are going on at Lowell prison and as of Sept. 14th there will be 4th meetings taking place. The new meeting is for 40 women inmates. They are considered youth offenders ~~from~~ between the ages of 17 to 23 years of age most of them are there for committing homicides under the influence of drugs. So far this new meeting will be held once a month at the main prison entrance. The prison has expressed that they would be grateful if we can eventually be able to bring in a NA meeting weekly, that is a doable goal if we can get possibly more NA women to step up and bring a meeting in even if they are able to do it ^{just} once a month.

Each meeting at Lowell has an average of 12-50 women at every meeting and on average monthly we have about 5 new comers that this has been their first NA meeting ever. There is a meeting going on in Lowell everyday of the week except Fridays, our newest meeting for the youths is held on Mondays so far →

It will be the second Monday of the month. We have a addict that is coming all the way from New Port Ritchey. To do this meeting, a very special Thank you goes out to Sara J. On behalf of all the women that are incarcerated at Jowell prison and attend our NA meetings I want to thank our area for the much appreciated literature.

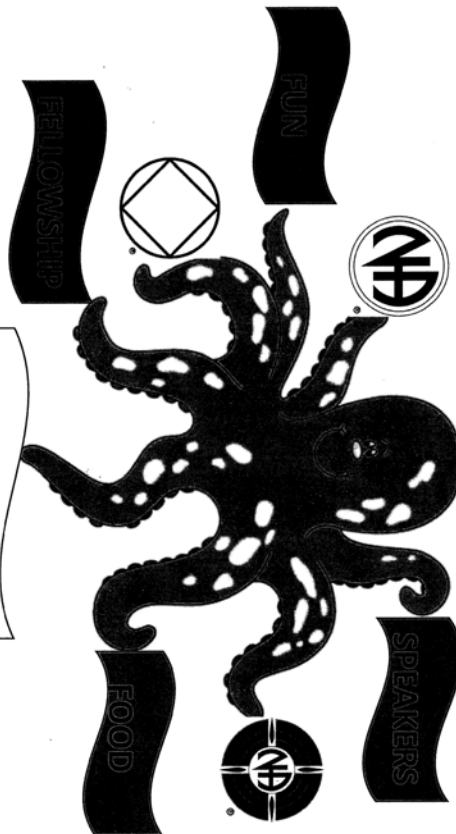
