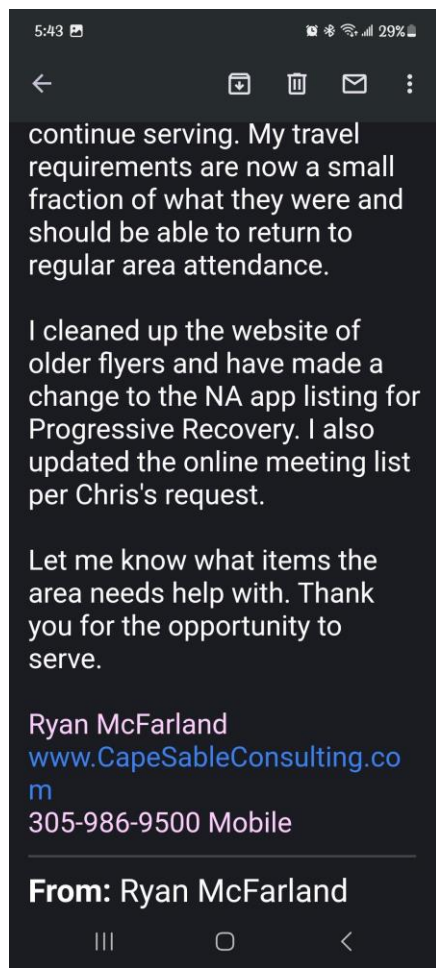
I apologize to the committee regarding my recent absences. Life showed up and have been confront life on its own terms.

The Subcommittee met on 8/7/23 to discuss the ongoing nomination for PR chairperson. We would like to first recognize our visiting member, Rick who was in attendance. We had a total of 7 volunteers to include:

I would like to apologize to the body for my absence today. I'm truly here in spirit. There was a motion made last month in regard to voting Charles D. as the new PR chairperson. We believe that, as a subcommittee, he is more than qualified to lead both the PR and Helpline subcommittee with prior RCM, Regional Helpline and other various forms of service. As per PR/Helpline policy, one must have six months of prior experience with both PR and Helpline. Charles has been with us but for a couple of months which ruled the motion out of order and was stricken from last month's minutes. A motion will be brought forward to vote Charles in once again and to add an amendment to waive the six month policy on service time. We will be referencing Tradition 5 and Concept 5. It is our hope that this will be uneventful.

At the moment, we have not heard from the Guest House or The Vines. We will try to continue reaching out until we establish contact. We also are talking about reaching out to the Ritz facility. From what is understood, there were prior meetings there and over the years and especially after Covid and undergoing staff changes, meetings have not occurred there. Charles and Rick will handle the cold calls for the Ritz. DJ spoke of the Ocala Fire Department to which he has a contact. He will bring our PR pull tab flyer and meeting lists to post there. There was talk of going into the schools to do presentations. It was suggested by Regional PR to visit and contact district school boards. Once again, our volunteer Sylvie spoke to Anna Reed who oversees Freedom Recovery High Schools in this region. Ms. Reed has been recognized for bringing awareness of drug addiction and recovery among our youth and her work is truly applauded.

The Helpline missed call percentage has gone up to 30% which is not good. We had a lapse in time frame when calls weren't going through due to internal error. After some configuration, we've added one member and another one was replaced. We would like to extend our heartfelt gratitude to Byrd for his tireless service to Narcotics Anonymous. He is now replaced by Willie M. All in all, we now have ten volunteers including two Spanish speaking volunteers.
