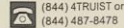

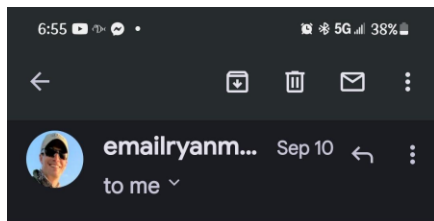

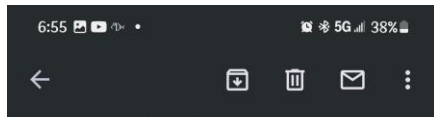

## PR / Helpline Subcommittee Report

Greetings,

The Subcommittee met on 9/4/23/ to discuss ongoing efforts for the upcoming events in September. Charles and I (Seuss) were able to secure a spot as a vendor at the 6th annual Recovery Fest sponsored by Marion County Children's Alliance which will be held at Tusawilla Park on Saturday, September 9th, 2023 from 10am-3pm. Charles will submit a receipt as proof of purchase for reimbursement. We are hoping to find ways to branch out with other organizations who will be in attendance at the event. As we visited the Alliance and spoke with staff there, we've been invited to attend their monthly meeting which was held on September 6th. The speakers included were from the Marion County Public Schools. We are working on getting appointments to set up PR presentations within the public school system. It will be a great opportunity to work alongside staff to help raise awareness of drug addiction among the youth and to bring to the forum the possibility of recovery for all. At the meeting Charles spoke with Laura Debick who is the Executive Director of Communications and Community Engagement for the Marion County Public Schools. She is now looking for dates that we can agree on so that our PR subcommittee can meet with her mental health and wellness team. We also had a discussion of NA approved PR flyers to be posted in the Marion County Children's Alliance's monthly newsletter. We have done research on this on the Regional and World level and we received positive feedback. This was to ensure that we are not violating any of our Traditions.

Sylvie and Charles attended the monthly Coffee Connections meeting over at Zero Life Hour on Tuesday, August 29th where they met with the Community Liaison for the Vines and a representative for White Sands treatment Center. We are in the process of scheduling dates for possible PR presentations with White Sands treatment facility. We have scheduled a presentation and tour of their facility with the Vines for September 15, 2023 at 09:00 am.

We've received a lot information about possible future connections with State and local law enforcement which would include Probation and Parole as well as Local EMS with the Marion County Fire Department and hope that by continuing the work we're doing will ensure that an addict can find a safe place to get clean, recover and find a new way to live.
