It has been a very productive month for the Forest Area PR We conducted our subcommittee meeting on October 2, 2023 where we had discussions on ongoing projects, presentations and community outreach efforts that we are currently involved in, which includes the meeting that we attended on September 6, 2023 by the Marion County Childers Alliance where there were various nonprofit organizations present where we provided several of them with meeting list, flyers and cards with our Phoneline line information, as well after speaking with Laura Debick the Executive Director of Communications and Community Engagement for the Marion County Public Schools we now have a meeting set for October 10, 2023 to provide them with a PR presentation.

The Marion County Children's Alliance also held their annual Recovery Fest on September 9,2023 10am to 3pm at Tuscawilla Park where we secured a spot and displayed our literature and provided attendees with vital information about our fellowship and how we can help.

Zuess and I also attended the monthly meeting on October 4, 2023 at the Marion County Children's Alliance, Where we provided meeting list and cards to various attendees, and we were asked to provide a presentation for the Ocala Opioid and Addiction Task Force on October 17, 2023 as well two other attendees asking for presentations more information to follow for those presentations. After speaking with Beth McCall the Executive Director of the Marion County Children's Alliance we have been added to the schedule of speakers for the monthly meeting in February to do a PR presentation at the monthly meeting.. I have included a copy of the flyer that we intend to submit to the Marion County Children's Alliance newsletter for the month of November.

Sylvie and I attended the monthly Coffee Connections meeting over at Zero Life Hour on September 26, 2023 where the meeting covered the path the addict that

is still suffering through the medical and clinical part of their recovery as well as helpful resources for housing and job assistance.

Capt. Jesse Blaire from the Ocala Fire Department EMS presented information about the (CORE) Coordinated Opioid Recovery network in conjunction with the Florida Department of Health Marion County that encompassed what they do from the time they come in contact with the struggling addict to the time they refer them to the other resources to help them in their recovery efforts which ultimately leads some of them to the rooms of Narcotic Anonymous, I have provided those resources that attended this meeting with meeting list as well as cards and flyers so that they know where to find us when the leave treatment.

We provided a presentation for the Vines Treatment Facility on September 15,2023 as well had a tour of the facility, the Vines was aware of who we are but had a lot of outdated meeting list and very few IP's that were interspersed with literature for the other fellowship they are asking for more literature and a literature rack for their IOP meetings.

As we previously informed you of a Presentation for the White Sands treatment facility we provided that presentation on October 4, 2023 where we shared what we are about with in person and virtual attendees and provided meeting list and various IP's and one of our flyers with the pull tabs for our Helpline.

I also attended the bi monthly Regional Zoom meeting that was held the Monday September 11, 2023 before the Regional weekend where we discussed various PR efforts in our Areas, of particular interest was the PR efforts of the Suncoast PR subcommittee in regards to our presence on social media (facebook and Instagram) we are looking into how that can be adapted here in the Forest Area if there is any one with experience in this area you help would be appreciated.

Our Helpline is operating as designed but there are still a few glitches getting all of the volunteers integrated into the system, we had no missed calls in September there were 11 volunteer calls 3 meeting look ups and 1 meeting lookup via sms. WE will continue efforts to get all of our volunteers intergraded into the system.

WE want to thank all of our volunteers for their endless work serving both our subcommittees. We meet the first Monday of the month a 8pm at 511 SE 3rd St. Ocala FL 34471 at the Presbyterian Church All are welcome because we are all PR.
