

We attended the monthly meeting of the Marion County Children's Alliance on January 10th where we networked with various service providers, and heard from the Agency spotlight speakers Dr. Barbara Brooks Brooks of R.A.M.A.L Educational and Social Services and Rick Haleman of Dads on Duty a organization of fathers that engage our Youth at their school with positive messaging, as well as the main speaker Wendy Proctor Director of Outreach and Development for Camp Boggy Creek a free camp for children with severe or chronic illnesses, if anyone would like more information about any of the service providers we encounter at these meetings we would get you the contact information. We did get our flyer into the Marion County Children's Alliance monthly news letter I have passed around a few copies of that newsletter for you to see.

We are in the process of scheduling a a on line presentation for the Freedom Springs Recovery High school.


We are also in the process of scheduling a joint meeting with H & I for the Gateway Foundation who is the treatment provider for the Florida Correction dept.
