Because of scheduling conflicts we did not attend the monthly Coffee and Connections meeting, and the next meeting will be held the last Tuesday of this month which we will be attending to network with service providers and provide them with information about our fellowship.

We attended the monthly meeting of the Marion County Children's Alliance on January 10<sup>th</sup> where we networked with various service providers, and heard from the Agency spotlight speakers Dr. Barbara Brooks Brooks of R.A.M.A.L Educational and Social Services and Rick Halem of Dads on Duty a organization of fathers that engage our youth at their school with positive messaging, as well as the main speaker Wendy Proctor Director of Outreach and Development for Camp Boggy Creek a free camp for children with severe or chronic illnesses, if anyone would like more information about any of the service providers we encounter at these meetings we would get you the contact information. We did get our flyer into the Marion County Children's Alliance monthly news letter I have passed around a few copies of that newsletter for you to see. We were supposed to be one of the spotlight speakers for the Marion County Children's Alliance monthly meeting February 7<sup>th</sup> 2024 but because of a scheduling conflict we were fortunately able to move that presentation to March more information to follow.

The Marion County Opioid Taskforce on January 4<sup>th</sup> was canceled but we will continue to attend when they are scheduled.

We are still looking into getting our information into the Marion County behavioral health Resource Guide upon researching this matter it has come to our attention that if we are going to continue carrying the message of Narcotics Anonymous to these providers with flyers cards that have our contact information directing them to our website the information about the Forest Area should be up to date and available to get the help that they are looking for, although there is a clear path to our help line and a address but the resource guide is asking for email and other contact information and we are not sure how to proceed with providing this information. So we are looking for guidance because we do not have a web servant at this time could we possibly get some help from other areas or from our region on how they have came up with a solution to this issue

We are in the process of scheduling a a on line presentation for the Freedom Springs Recovery High school.

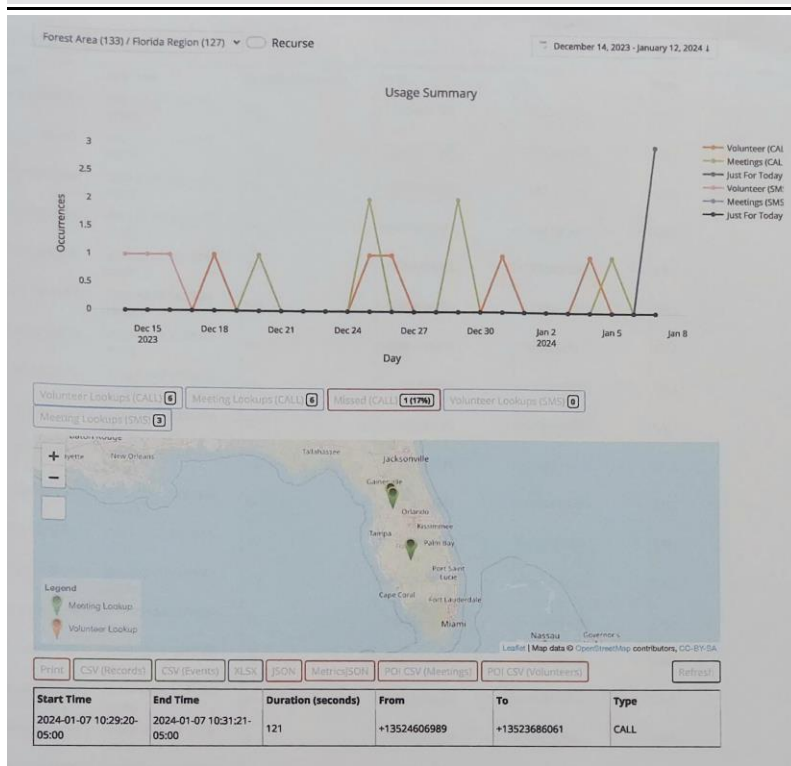
We are also in the process of scheduling a joint meeting with H & I for the Gateway Foundation who is the treatment provider for the Florida Correction dept.
