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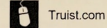

We had another productive month for the Forest Area public Relations subcommittee on October 17th we provided a PowerPoint presentation for the Community Council Against Substance Abuse (Opioid Task Force) Sponsored by the Marion County Children's Alliance via zoom other Presentations included members from Career Source, and the Community Council, subjects included Drug Trends, New Initiatives and resources available through the Community Council such as an Outreach Campaign, Locking Medication Bags, Narcan Kits, Medication Disposal Kits, and a Adult Mental Health First Aid Class to be held on December 12th if you would like information about any of the subjects that were discussed at this meeting let me know and I will get you the information. The next Opioid Task Force meeting will be held on December 7, 2023.

We attended the Marion County Children's Alliance monthly meeting on November 1, 2023 where there were presentations done by Stephanie Gavin from Big Brother Big Sister organization asking for volunteers if you are interested volunteering see me after and I will get you her contact information. Other speakers were from the Marion Senior services. We provided attendees with meeting list and flyers so that they know where to find us. We have submitted the flyer that was submitted to the body to be included in the December issue of the Marion County Children's Alliance Newsletter I will make a copy available to the Area when it is distributed.

We attended the monthly Coffee Connections meeting on October 31, 2023 which was hosted by the Vines and attended by Geoff Oetjen Vines Community Liaison, Puirdie Burks Vines Military and Veteran liaison, Melanie Gavani Out patient therapist White Sands Treatment, Heidi Burns Administrative Case Manager White Sands Treatment, Capt. Jesse Blaire Ocala Fire Department EMS, and representatives from Zero life where we discussed ongoing efforts and resources for addicts in various stages of their recovery. Information was provided to all attendees where to find us when they leave treatment. At this meeting we also have been informed that there is a Marion County Behavioral Health Guide and we are looking into the possibility of getting our information into this guide. 
Two members were not present to present their feedback on their assigned sections of policy.

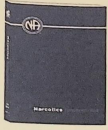
