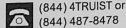

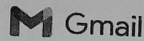

PR / Helpline Subcommittee Report

Greetings,

Happy New Year! Wishing one and all a safe, happy and prosperous year.

The subcommittee met on 1/2/23 to discuss topics in regards of our continuing efforts to reach out to facilities for possible PR presentations. We had two new members joining our subcommittee. Richard R and Shawn M. which totalled 6 members in attendance. Mark M. was tasked to acquire contact information on facilities like Brothers Keeper, The Salvation Army and Interfaith Emergency Services for possible H and I presentations. We are moving forward with the flyer posting campaign to post in public venues. We will speak with probation and parole officers and also visit Sheriff's offices and local police departments to help bring awareness and information for addicts to find us. We will visit libraries and municipalities keeping in mind to ask for permission prior to posting our flyers.

We are happy to report that we are receiving calls from the Helpline. Since adding the spanish prompt on the Yap system, we've received a call on Monday from an addict looking for a spanish meeting. Mac, one of our volunteers, and I were able to direct them to one of our meetings in which we met and explained to them the process of going to meetings. All went well. Our percentage of missed calls has dropped to less than 25%. Some calls come through as meeting lookups meaning that people are calling specifically to search for meetings or to hear the Just for Today meditation of that day. I've acquired documents from another area entitled "Phoneline Basics" which is NA approved literature. Each volunteer received a copy. This entails a refresher so that our volunteers stay in the loop of our "do's and don't's" for Helpline service. We will forward a copy for review.

We also discussed our Service Awareness Day activity to be held in March. As information becomes available to us about our role in service awareness, we will respond accordingly. In regard to the Vines facility, we have yet to have anyone to take in an H and I presentation. We will reach out to the contact person to inform them of this and hopefully by next month we will have someone out there. We are also waiting to hear from the Marion County Children's Alliance about any future recovery events

We would humbly like to thank our volunteers and members of our subcommittee for doing a great job in helping to carry the message to the addict who still suffers. We are grateful for their service.

We meet the first Monday of the month at 511 SE 3rd st. at 8pm following our H and I subcommittee meeting. You need only one day clean to be of service. Any and all suggestions are welcome.

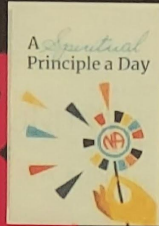
