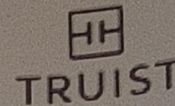

WCNA PR Forums – for those who attended WCNA PR Forums, did you learn anything and/or how they can be improved

- NM -Attended several presentation – enjoyed seeing folks of the next generation being involved and participating; need presentation for ‘high level’ folks such as judges
- C&P -Take away – gave presentation to Boy Scout -do not say I am an addict instead Hi Anne, I am a member in long term recovery. Heard in language workshop
- NEZF PR - Went to 5 presentations – government officials – interesting especially Marshall Smith from Canada. Compared differences what they were able to do. 75% reduction in ODs. Would have like roundtable, smaller setting, and leave time for networking. Only 7 minutes left for questions. Networking may helped being able to tease out things to bring back.
- PA - Fabulous to have so many focused workshops and avenues for discussion and willingness of presenters gave out their information and gave out their emails. Willingness to interact and felt like they wanted to hear from us.
- Chicagoland - Feedback at home and folks wanting to join PR. Signing up folks daily; very interested in RO.

- Brazil Zone – serves forum as chair for PR. Participated in last day on webinar – loved seeing the inmates participating. All a result of credibility worldwide – building in relation to our message and program. Inmates reached members worldwide.

- Some communities are having inmates in their presentations within DOC. Very effective and powerful.
- FL WCNA – grateful for PR workshops – professionals who attended and they are in recovery. Every PR workshop amazed by attendees and the interest for PR. Put on virtual PR meeting so area chairs can be a resource for each other. Hope is better collaboration.

What is the main focus for your PR committee?

- PA- Message of NA not well known in treatment centers and rehabs. How do we let them know about NA. New area formed and wanting to network. Trying to re-establish phonenumber. Need to have phonenumber orientation with do's and don'ts. How do we network with other agencies. Trying to make presence known – bus sign and billboard. Have fund constraints. Have QR code. Wants to be part of the solution
- Chicagoland – learning days. Each area is putting on learning days – joy of doing service and make fun. Attraction. Resource in the Community, MS updated?? Collecting MS surveys and will be able to get new stats out after.
- NY LI- 15 years – trainings. Resource tables and put out literature and meeting lists. Lack of interested members to participate. Small committee.
- Michigan – regional level in statewide events. Drug courts, substance abuse – 1200+ attendance. \$300/table. Areas have tables in Recovery Month – get thanked. Tribal opioid event – NA is viable
- FL – re-build PR committee in area. Prior to COVID had made advances in community; now trying to reestablish and maintain. Recruitment of young people – bring someone to the next meeting and see whether they are interested. Establish new relationships with new entities that are permanent – public library system, baseball, EMS. QR code goes to meeting lists, website, helpline. Engage helpline in PR. Think outside box – get new relationships started and see what happens. Collaboration with other areas sparks new ideas. Bringing in H&I.
- NEZF PR – meets virtually for zones. – have 15-18 PR chairs. Assist with area/regional committees and put on professional days. Had workshops in DC. Address stigmatizing language – creating barriers with professionals. Addresses our language and barriers lessened. FAQ IP for PR and PPT – explains PR. Theatres for PSA's \$2500.

- CT – big project to put billboards. Has graphic to share. Media project for PR – 9 billboards with one in each area. 1 month or longer if no one wants spot. & 8K. Billboards have secondary phone # to see if the billboards are working – tracking results. New Posters – QR code link is for website and track results with google analytics. Trying to find out where folks are coming from. \$5/month for extra phone #.
- BC – working closely with Quebec who are modifying posters. 11 areas are requesting posters. New social media coordinator. FB and tick tok. PR booths – 3 new ones in May. Used more in last 6 months than in 7 years. Learning Days. Went from 7 prison volunteers to 30.
- Brazil – huge territory – 1060 groups, 4600 meetings/week; 160 area subcommittees and 11 regions. Service diversified – levels of development varies – those who joined us from prisons had to be appointed by judges – vast amount of prisons inmates are participating including homeless and wives. Expanded services to various public agencies. Professionals working together with NA – public health participate in NA events. Education MS public safety invited and many know about NA – encourage folks to go to NA and appreciate their help because they get to places NA hasn't gone; PR activities and outreach – joined 160 members. Simultaneous activities for a month and come together after month to recap. Raise funds to reach outlier places. Local county government offices are opening doors for NA – focused on solution.

Have you seen an increase or decrease in requests?

- SC – project based service. Small committee – have a project where members can be brought in without a long commitment. Trying to implement this year. PR committee met with Director of county library – had 11 managers for presentation. Gave BTs and a literature rack with schedules. Free digital billboard – needs help. Doing their best to attract members – showed 2 videos We all are PR and NAWS growth – members enthusiastic.
- So Cal – project based – such as reach out to homeless, businesses. Pass out literature and how they can find NA. Fire Dept – reached out to fire and EMS. Doing outreach for conferences. Conference – booth – MH for schools – ran out of literature (800 pcs) in 6 ½ hours. Keeping Families Together conference in Feb. Continue with parolee meetings – 100 Tuesday am and 125 Thursday evening. Byus sings created and about ready to go up Streaming info on DMV.

- Carolina Region – working in tandem with No Carolina Regiion – OD awareness presentation. Western No Carolina area hit by hurricane – desimated. Bringing BT, booklets. Meeting place no more. Yearly events – Addiction Medicine, NC1 conference managed care attends, BMLT and have QR condes. Looking to get areas involved in regional committee.
- NEZF PR – concentrating into prisons – Ohio State and NY state parole and prison – left meeting and more dialogue. Trying to get virtual meetings to NY prisons.
- C&P – pamphlet PR in action – PR in pictures and shows how PR works – flyers.
