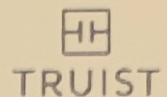

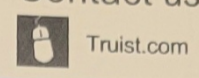

Fellowship Development

#1 = Lack of clarity regarding procedural guidelines during meetings/long-standing members feeling marginalized after a controversial vote in a group which may have not had a full understanding of NA concepts and traditions.

Feedback: Mentorship/Orientation for new GSRs to help ensure that everyone understands NA concepts and traditions and can effectively participate in discussions and decision-making. Tabling votes until there is a full understanding of the proposals, helping to maintain integrity of communication (a key part of NA's eighth concept).

#2 = Big Bend: Budget/Falling below prudent reserve/Routine costs furthering financial

difficulty within the Area. A mix of fewer donations and ongoing expenses are contributing to the issue.

Feedback: Money Matters IP, looking at the 11th concept. Resetting budgets to match last year's expenses and prioritizing essential expenses (helpline, H&I literature) vs. non-essential expenses (newsletter, travel reimbursement for RCM).

#3 = Liability insurance for groups.

Feedback: The more areas that participate, the lower the cost. Mark B requested information from Areas in order to provide accurate information to insurance providers in order to get quotes that would cover all meetings and events (added on a case-by-case basis) in participating areas. Areas do not need to be incorporated to be covered under the insurance plan. The IRS recognizes NA as an unincorporated association of individuals, which meets the requirements for obtaining liability insurance without the need for 501(c)(3) or LLC status. However, if areas already had nonprofit status, it wouldn't interfere with participating in the regional insurance program.

#4= River Coast: Prudent reserve and struggling with lack of donations from home groups. RCM stated that her home group maintains a prudent reserve of two months rent, and that two out of ten home groups financially support the area.

Feedback: Not operating above an Area's means, relying on home group donations and not activities/event revenue. Determining how much goes into a prudent reserve (often it's two months of expenses). Educating GSRs and groups on 7th tradition, donations, and prudent reserve. Review Money Matters IP and 11th concept.

#5 = Florida Region facilitating the Florida Service Symposium or turning it over to the Zone.

Feedback: Discussed reducing extra costs should the FSS remain regional. Continuing the Women in Service dinner by integrating it into a local event, such as the GSR assembly.

Good afternoon we attended the monthly meeting with the Marion County Children's Alliance on October 2nd the spotlight speakers included Carly Sullivan-Orozco the Business Development Representative from the Phoenix House treatment center and Lavonda Goodson, CEO from the Estelle Byrd Whitman Center which is a community health center serving West Ocala and the surrounding area. After the meeting we met with Carly Sullivan-Orozco from the Phoenix house and Anna Racicot of Perspectives integrated treatment and sober living serving Summerfield, Ocala and Brooksville as well as Monica DaSilva the Health Education Program Liaison of the Florida Department of Health Hepatitis C Clinic and we in the process of scheduling presentations with each of them as soon as the area recovers from the last two weather events. As always we provided information to the Alliance information on where to find us. The next Alliance meeting will be held on November 6th at the Mary Sue Rich Center, Due to Hurricane Helene Community Council against substance abuse meeting on September 23rd at the Sheriff Department Multipurpose room 3300 NW 10th St Ocala FL 34475 was canceled.

On October 2nd in collaboration with our H&I subcommittee we provided a presentation for the Vines in patient treatment facility. We are also exploring the possibility of providing a presentation for the local Nursing schools in our area, as they are required to attend our meetings as a part of their rotation.

Just a reminder PR is not just for the professional community it is also internal for our members because WE Are ALL PR !!

We attended the Virtual Regional PR meeting Monday September 9th which was held the Monday before regional weekend where we continued discussions on what outreach looks like and how to more effectively carry the message of recovery as well as what PR events that are upcoming in the other areas in our region. I attend the North Carolina Regions first Service Symposium that was held in Weddington NC on September 28th and I attended workshops on Vision for NA service carrying the message through H&I and PR, where we discussed the efforts and projects that are going on in our areas, as well as a overview of our service system, information about the collaboration of zones, Atmosphere of recovery in service, as well as roundtable discussions on Reimagining and Revitalizing Service Committees.

We set up our PR booth at the 7th Annual Ocala Recovery Festival which was sponsored by the Marion County Children's Alliance on September 14th at Tusawilla Park 500 NE 9th St Ocala FL.

Our Helpline is operating as designed we had no missed calls from September 9th to October 12th we had 5 volunteer lookup calls, 4 meeting look up calls and 0 meeting lookups via text and 0 volunteer lookups via text. 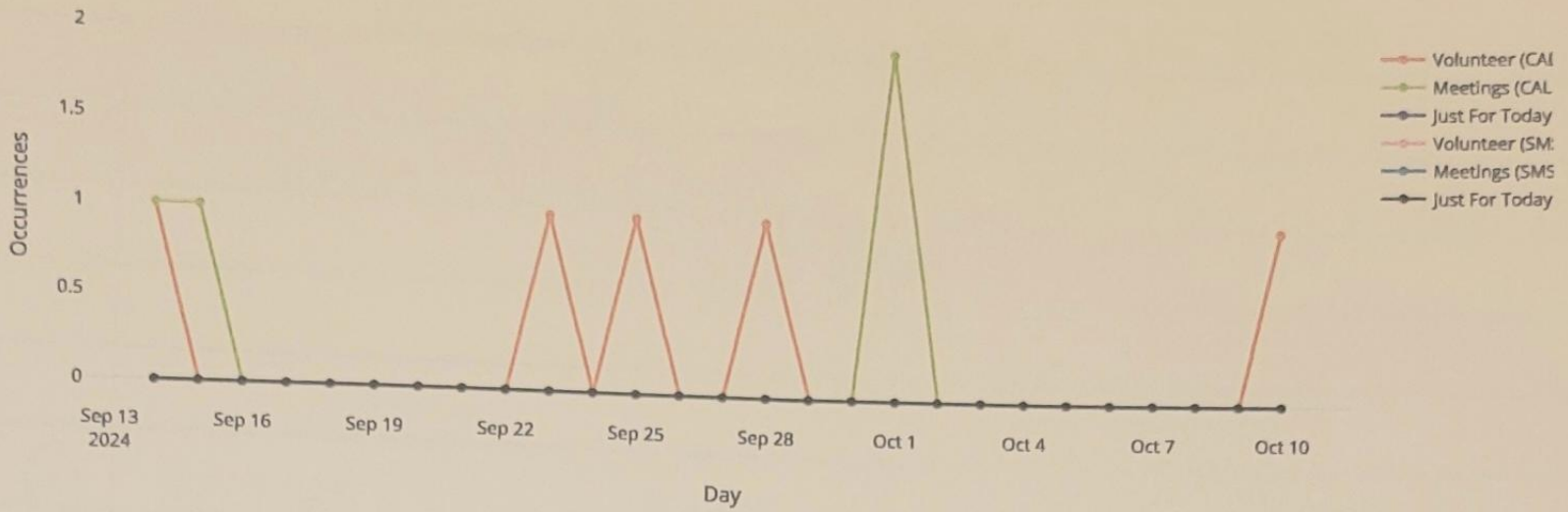

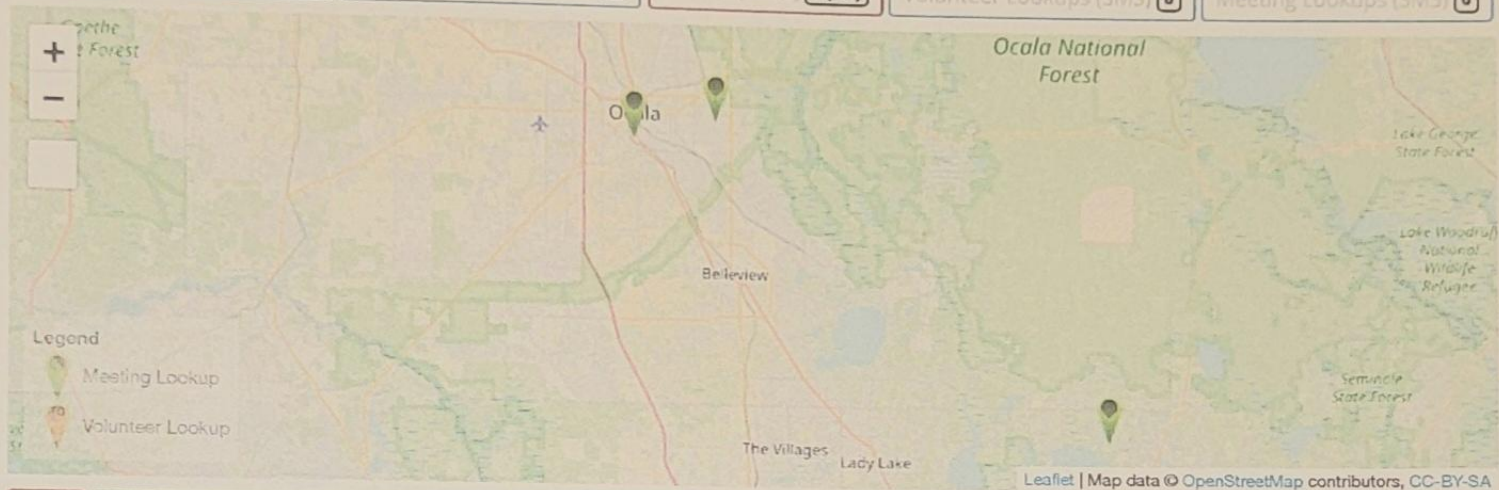
