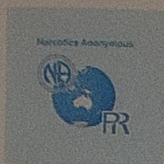

We also attended the Safe streets of Marion County Taskforce where we discussed plans for the next Alliance event a Teen Summit to be held June 7th at the Howard Academy 306 NW 7th Ave Ocala where we have been asked to be a vendor. The next Alliance meeting will be held on April 2nd at the Mary Sue Rich Center. We will be attending the Community Council against substance abuse on March 17th via Zoom.
