# **Fellowship Development**

We had a Forest Area member join us for FD who actively participated in a round table discussion regarding literature for younger members. We would like to put together a visual map of all areas in the region/in FL. Please see me if interested in helping.

# Issue Discussion Topics

#1 = Some home groups have been modifying NA-approved literature by using gender-neutral language and replacing "God" with "Higher Power."

Feedback: While this technically goes against the Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust (FIPT), the World Service Office is not enforcing restrictions and is leaving the matter to local areas. Members acknowledged concerns about consistency but emphasized that groups are trusted to act responsibly within the Traditions, as there is no formal enforcement or "literature police" in NA. Is it preventing us from sharing the message?

#2 = Drop in GSR attendance at Area meetings

Feedback: Areas handle group participation at Area differently—some remove voting rights after missed ASC meetings, while others focus on outreach by delivering materials and offering support. One area created a committee to re-engage inactive groups. Incentives to attend ASC, like food (especially pizza) were noted as effective. Long, unproductive meetings were seen as discouraging, and streamlining agendas was suggested to boost participation. Most agreed that groups should stay on meeting lists unless they've stopped meeting entirely, emphasizing support over punishment. Orientation and mentorship for new GSRs were highlighted as effective ways to encourage involvement.

#3 = Suncoast creating a convention

Feedback: Form an ad-hoc committee after receiving a motion from a home group. FD offered willingness to support the process if the Area is not sufficiently supporting it.

#4= Young people's meetings

Feedback: Discussed having recreational events geared towards younger members, having meetings at youth facilities (such as Arnette House in Ocala), meetings at high schools or bringing young people together virtually. This led to a round table workshop.

#5 = A non-addict helping with a convention subcommittee (spouse of an addict) and a formal complaint was filed by a member.

Feedback: This violates our 7th tradition, he could be paid as a special worker. Most subcommittees have clean time requirements that would ensure that the member is a person with a drug problem.




